Timeline for the congregational vote on Faith's building project: The council and the building committee would like to make you aware of some important events and dates leading up to the congregational vote on the proposed building project.

1) Sunday January 16: Case statements with the proposed building drawings will be placed in your mailboxes. You will also be able to view large poster board drawings in the back of the fellowship hall. This will allow you to study the plan, ask questions of the council or building committee, and pray. Pray that the Lord will lead us in this process and that his will be done.

2) Wednesday, January 26 at 7:00PM an informational/question and answer meeting will be held at church for anyone interested in more details and a chance to ask questions about the construction project. Your attendance is encouraged by the council and building committee.

3) Monday, February 7 at 7:15-8:15 PM Immanuel CRC of Orange City will host an open house for any of our congregants who would like to see their sanctuary. Our proposed sanctuary design is similar to Immanuel's.

4) Sunday, February 13, following the morning service Faith CRC members will vote by ballot on the plan. Those who cannot be in attendance may vote by absentee ballot. A 75% approval level is needed to move the project forward into fund raising.
